

Prep Sheet for Bed Bug Chemical Treatment

This service will include a multi-layered approach to control, including residual chemical treatments, dusting of electrical outlets, cracks and crevices, vacuuming and steaming of mattresses, box springs and couches etc. Proper preparation is important and is required, so your technicians can access all the areas they need to quickly eradicate your problem.

- All clothing, linens and textiles that are easily washed or dry cleaned must be washed or dry cleaned and stored in sealed plastic bags. Double bagging is advised as small rips can lead to big problems. Textiles include drapes and fabric wall hangings.
- All untreatable articles such as alarm clocks, lamps, collectables and décor must be stored in sealed bags. This uncluttering of the environment will help the process and lead to more effective treatment.
- While preparing, remember that closets and shelving will need to be treated.
 All electronics will need to be unplugged to give the technician access to the switch plates for dusting.
- In some cases, heavily infested furniture, appliances or other articles may have to be thrown out.
- All people and pets will need to be out of the house during the treatment and then for a period of 4-6 hours after the treatment is completed as well for air out time. If you have respiratory issues, are pregnant or have children under a year old, you must be stay out a minimum of 24 hours.
- If you have pets that cannot be moved, such as fish, their tanks should be covered and aerators and filters turned off.

This service will take 2.5 to 4.5 hours to complete on a standard house. The follow up service must be booked 10-14 days from the initial service. This is designed to break the life cycle.



High quality mattress and box spring encasements are recommended to prevent future infestation.

Proper preparation is crucial for the control of bedbugs. Please have all preparations completed prior to the arrival of your technicians.

					1.) All easy-to-wash linens, clothing and textiles including drapes and fabric wall hangings are cleaned and double bagged.
					2.) All untreatable items like alarm clocks, lamps, collectables are sealed in bags.
					3.) All electronics are unplugged for quick access to switch plates. Furniture is pulled away from all perimeter walls for access to baseboards.
					4.) All Animals must be out of the home being treated. Such animals include Birds, Ferrets, Reptiles and domestic animals.
					5.) If you have pets that cannot be removed, such as fish, their tanks must be covered and aerators and filters turned off.
					6.) Be prepared to vacate the home during treatment and remain out of the environment for 4-6 hours. Or 24 hours if you are pregnant, have respiratory issues or have children under 12 months old.
					7.) Be prepared for a follow up service in 10 - 14 days after the initial treatment to break the life cycle of Bed Bugs
					8.) Consider purchasing a mattress and boxspring encasement to prevent future Bed Bug infestations. We will install Free of Charge!
					9.) The home for treatment is decluttered for access by technicians. An uncluttered environment will maximize the effectiveness of the treatment.
