

## **Prep Sheet for Bed Bug Heat treatment**

Proper preparation is crucial for the success of your treatment for bedbugs. With your help, our technician team will solve your issue. Please make sure all preparations are completed for your service appointment.

Very little, if anything should be removed from the environment prior to the heat treatment.

- All electronics must be unplugged, including computers.
- All prescription drugs should be stored in the fridge during the treatment.
- All fruits such as apples and bananas should be stored in the fridge.
- Heat susceptible furniture (bamboo, wicker) should be marked so technicians are aware. These will have their own individual heat sensor or can be removed from the environment if required.
- Candles and wax figures and sculptures should be placed separately as they will be inspected and removed from the environment so they will not melt.
- All combustibles must be removed from the environment. (Examples: Gas lanterns, oil lamps, fireworks, ammunition, barbeque lighters)
- All pressurized cans, cylinders and bottles must be removed. (Examples: aerosol bug sprays, fire extinguishers, lighters, perfume, deodorant.)
- Oil paintings and anything of high personal and sentimental value should be separated for technicians to inspect and treat appropriately.



You can expect technicians to be on site 7-12 hours to complete this type of service.

High quality mattress and box spring encasements are always recommended to prevent future problems.

					1.) All electronics are unplugged including computers, alarm clocks and T.V's
					2.) All prescription drugs, medications and pills are stored in the fridge.
					3.) All fresh fruits such as Apples and Bananna's are stored in the fridge.
					4.) All heat susceptible furniture such as Bamboo and Wicker is marked for technician or noted below.
					5.) All wax candles and figurines are gathered together for technician to inspect and remove from the environment.
					6.) All combustibles are removed from the environment. Such items include (Gas lanterns, oil lamps, fireworks, ammunition, barbeque lighters)
					7.) All pressurized cans, cylinders and bottles are removed from environment. Such items include (Aerosol bug sprays, fire extinguishers, lighters, perfume and deodorant)
					8.) All items with high sentimenatal value are marked or noted below for techni- cians to inspect and remove from environment. Such items include (Oil Paint- ings, Heirlooms
					9.) All Pets and Plants <b>must</b> be removed from the home being treated. This includes Birds, Ferret's, Reptiles, Flowers, and potted vegetation.
